
Immanuel Broadcasting Network ("Immanuel"), pursuant to Section 73.3598(b) of the Commission's Rules, hereby requests a tolling of the Construction period for its New FM Translator Station W270CP at Atlanta, Georgia. A construction Permit was issued to Immanuel on April 1, 2015 (copy attached). Thereafter, on June 10, 2015 D2 Broadcasting Company, LLC filed an Informal Objection asking that the Commission rescind that grant. The receipt of such Reconsideration Petition was memorialized on the Broadcast Applications Public Notice, report No. 28510, released June 15, 2015 (copy attached). On June 30, 2015 Immanuel filed an opposition to the petition. As of this date, the Informal Objection (reconsideration request) remains on file.

Immanuel has been informed that a tolling of the construction period is provided for under Section 73.3598(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules, but that such tolling may only be deemed effective as of a date that is no earlier than 30 days prior to the date on which such request for tolling is filed.

Accordingly Immanuel hereby requests that its construction permit be tolled as of a date that is thirty days prior to the date that this request is received by the Commission. Such a tolling date would leave approximately 30 months of construction time on the permit when the construction clock restarts. Immanuel is aware of its obligation to keep staff advised of the status of this matter.
