Dear Mr. Denning:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 14, 2014. RLHC requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 25, 2011, to operate with an emergency ND antenna and reduced power due to tornado damage. In support of the request, RLHC stated that additional time is needed to allow for further action on the AM Revitalization proceeding (MB Docket 13-249) before restoring operations by improving the licensed facility.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WKY may continue to operate with an emergency ND antenna using the 94.6° night tower #2(SW),

and reduced power not to exceed 5 kW daytime and 1.25 kW nighttime, as necessary to facilitate all repairs. Operation also is authorized during nighttime hours with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RLHC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. Due to the recent adoption of the AM Revitalization proceeding², Cumulus must begin preparations to file an FCC Form 301 application to show that substantial progress has been made (if not planning on making all repairs to resume operations via the current license).

This authority expires on May 13, 2016.
