## Dear Applicant:

The above-captioned application for a minor modification to a construction permit proposes to change channels from 238L1 to 276L1. The Second Report & Order in MM Docket 99-25 established the definition of a "minor change" as it applies to LPFM applications. The Commission stated that minor changes of LPFM stations may include changes of frequencies to adjacent or IF frequencies or, upon a technical showing of reduced interference, to any frequency. The claim of interference from the un-built translator station W237DW is insufficient to demonstrate reduced interference. Therefore, the instant application specifying a non-adjacent channel change without an adequate technical showing of reduced interference violates Section 73.870(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules.<sup>2</sup>

In light of the above, application BPL-20150220ABB IS HEREBY DISMISSED.<sup>3</sup> This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>4</sup>
