Dear Mr. Martin:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 9, 2015. SEB requests an extension of the STA grantee on May 13, 2015, to operate station KWWJ(AM) with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within license limits to allow time to file an FCC Form 301 minor change application to correct known height and coordinate errors on the last license (BL-19960503AD).¹ In support of the request SEB states that its consulting engineer is preparing the required FCC Form 301 application for filing.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WWJ(AM) may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce

power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. SEB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that SEB will file an acceptable FCC Form 301 application to correct all errors before the expiration date shown below to show that substantial progress has been made.

This authority expires on **June 7, 2016**.
