
Radio Training Network (“RTN”), licensee of the above referenced station, by its counsel, hereby requests, pursuant to Section 73.3598(b)(2) of the Commission’s Rules, that the period of construction be tolled due to the pending Petition for Reconsideration filed on April 18, 2014 by Cox Radio, Inc. Section 73.3598(b)(2) provides that “the period of construction for an original construction permit shall toll when construction is prevented by the following causes not under the control of the permittee: (2) the grant of the permit is the subject of administrative...review (i.e. petitions for reconsideration... of a construction permit pending before the Commission...)”.

On March 14, 2014, the Commission granted the above referenced application to RTN for a minor change in Station WVFJ-FM’s facilities. Although Cox filed a Petition for Reconsideration within the 30 day period, RTN expected the matter to be resolved before now. Since this proceeding is still pending, RTN would like to preserve the remaining period of time left on its permit before expiration.
