Dear Ms. Cox-Henley:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned application to change the channel of WJCF from Channel 201 to 262. An informal objection has been filed against this application by Cumulus Licensing, LLC.

This application was filed one day after application BMPH-20070118AEZ for WYGB (Facility ID. No. 18668), Morristown, IN and conflicts with the earlier filed application. Under the Commission's processing system for FM commercial minor change applications, FM commercial minor change applications are processed on a first come / first served basis. Later filed applications are "held in queue" behind the first-filed or lead application.<sup>1</sup> If the lead application is granted, the queue is dissolved and the queue applications are dismissed; if the lead application is dismissed, then the first queue application (the application filed closest in time after the lead application) is processed.

In the present instance, the staff granted the lead application BMPH-20070118AEZ on March 22, 2007. As a result, the first come / first served queue is dissolved. Application BPH-20070119AGQ, as a part of that queue, IS DISMISSED, and Cumulus Licensing, LLC's informal objection is dismissed as moot. Please note that we have not to date considered any matters raised in the informal objection, nor have we examined the application for other defects that could preclude acceptance, but we reserve the right to do so should Indiana Community Radio Corporation file an appeal of this dismissal.
