Dear Ms. Cherry:

This is in reference to the request filed on December 4, 2015. JTC requests a second extension of the STA granted on February 10, 2015, to operate station WPUL(AM) with temporary facilities at an alternate site using an existing shorter tower (due to problems with the licensed site facility).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, JTC requests additional time to locate a new suitable permanent site for the station.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

• Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;

• Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or

• No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and JTC may continue to operate station WPUL(AM) with the following facilities:

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. WPUL(AM) must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. Since it appears that resuming licensed operations at the old licensed site is not a viable option, JTC must retain a private consulting engineer in the near future to begin preparing the required FCC Form 301 application for a new permanent site facility (in order to show that substantial progress has been made).

This authority expires on July 1, 2016.
