This is in reference to the request filed on December 9, 2015. TMMO requests a second extension of the STA granted on December 2, 2014, to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within license limits due to ground system and reradiation problems.\(^1\) In support of its request TMMO states that additional time is needed to complete all work before an FCC Form 302 application can be filed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station

¹ WOBM(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1160 kHz with 5 kW day and 8.9 kW night.

WOBM(AM) may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. TMMO must file an FCC Form 302 application with a day and night partial proof before the expiration date shown below due to ground system repairs and the required detuning of a nearby tower. Otherwise the next request must contain all the new steps taken by TMMO to show that substantial progress has been made towards resumption of licensed operations.

This authority expires on July 5, 2016.
