On January 11, 2016 I received your letter regarding AM station WRJE(AM) on 1600 kHz at Dover, Delaware. However, I am sorry to inform you that the station's license has been cancelled for failure to respond within 30 days of our letter which was dated December 2, 2015. The letter requested that you provide the following:

Evidence documenting the Station's operational status since January 14, 2014, the date of silence noted in its last renewal application,2 indicating the location, effective radiated power and antenna height above ground level for all periods of operation. Also include copies of all leases, personnel records, engineering records, station logs, invoices, bills, checks written or received, credit card charges, wire transfers or deposits of funds relating to the Station's operation. Please include pictures of the Station's facilities during this timeframe, and provide exact Station coordinates.

Unfortunately we did not receive a response within 30 days and the letter response we did receive provided very little regarding the information that was requested.
