Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 25, 2006, by Ann Bavender, Esq., on behalf of South Texas Broadcasting, Inc. ("STB"). STB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on February 27, 2006 to operate Station KLUP with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.¹ In support of the request, STB states that a repairs are proceeding but additional time is required for completion of the work.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KLUP may

¹ KLUP is licensed for operation on 930 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. STB must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² STB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 27, 2007**.
