E-String Wireless, Ltd. ("E-String"), permittee of FM translator station K288GM, Sweetwater, Texas, together with San Antonio RadioWorks, LLC ("SARW"), the proposed assignee of K288GM, hereby request a waiver (47 CFR §1.3 and §73.3598) of the construction deadline for the K288GM construction permit pursuant to Note 36 in the *First Report and Order, Further Notice of Proposed Rule Making and Notice of Inquiry* in MB Docket No. 13-249, *Revitalization of the AM Radio Service*, 30 FCC Rcd 12145 (2015).


K288GM has a permit that was granted as a result of the Auction 83 window filings (see BNPFT-20030317HSQ, BNPFT-20130328ATU), and the permit is scheduled to expire on April 30, 2016. This permit is being sold to SARW, and a separate application (BAPFT-20160128ANX) is pending for consent to the assignment of the K288GM construction permit from E-String to SARW. SARW has separately filed a 250 mile window application (BMPFT-20160129AVG) to relocate K288GM in order to rebroadcast SARW-licensed AM station KAHL(AM), San Antonio, Texas. In the attached certification, SARW commits to promptly constructing and initiating operation of the translator once the pending assignment application and proposed 250 mile window relocation application are granted so that KAHL(AM) can be rebroadcast as contemplated in the AM Revitalization Order.

Accordingly, E-String and SARW respectfully request a waiver of 47 CFR §1.3 and §73.3598 to toll the construction deadline of the permit for


K288GM for six months from the later of the grant of the above-referenced assignment application or grant of the above-referenced modification application filed in the 250 mile window.
