Request for Extension of Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Peltzman:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 12, 2016, on behalf of Shilo Communications, Inc. ("SCI"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit AM Radio Station WRRL to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that SCI stated that Station WRRL(AM) went silent on July 13, 2015, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on August 19, 2015, and expired on February 15, 2016. SCI requests extension of its STA for continued technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

SCI's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WRRL(AM) to remain silent until July 13, 2016. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WRRL(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., July 14, 2016.**<sup>1</sup>

SCI is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If SCI does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
