Dear Mr. Lui:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 17, 2016. WBL requests a third extension of the STA granted on July 2, 2014, to operate from the construction permit site (BP-20131223AF1). In support of its STA request, WBL states that the new license application BMML-20151020AJS currently remains pending before the Commission.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WZHF(AM) may continue to operate with the following facilities:

<sup>1</sup> WZHF(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1390 kHz with 5 kW (unlimited), and the construction permit BP-20131223AF1 authorizes a change in site and patterns.

In addition, WBL may operate the station pursuant to Section 73.1615 and the terms and conditions of BP-20131223AFI with the substantially adjusted daytime and nighttime patterns based upon the proof submitted in BMML-20151020AJS. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. WBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47CFR 1.1310. We anticipate that a PTA will be granted before the expiration date shown below, eliminating the need for further STA operation.

This authority expires on June 7, 2016.
