This is in reference to the above captioned application, the Commission's letter of February 12, 2015 informing you of the red light status and the related correspondents.<sup>1</sup>

The subject application has been held in abeyance pursuant to the Commission's "red light" rules which prohibit the staff from processing an application when the applicant is delinquent on debts owed to the FCC.<sup>2</sup> We believe that it is not in the public interest to hold these applications for an indefinite period of time. We have afforded Delta Radio Network, LLC, more than eight (8) months, to pay or arrange for payment of the delinquent debt with the Commission's Office of Managing Director<sup>3</sup> and are now dismissing it pursuant to Section 1.1910(b)(3) and Section 73.3568(a)(1) application of the Commission's rules.
