

Dear Mr. Walls:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 22, 2016. CCBL requests further extension of the STA originally granted on June 16, 1981, for operation with an increased power of 10 kW (day and night) to overcome Cuban interference.¹ In support of the request, CCBL states that the Cuban interference continues.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WIOD may continue to operate with 10 kW (per BZ-20040227ACD).² It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CCBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. Station WIOD must resume 5 kW licensed operations (per BZ-19901121AE) if the Cuban interference ceases, or upon official notice from the Commission. This authority expires on **September 11, 2016**.
