Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to §73.1560(d), Airen Broadcasting Company, the permittee of Station KBAE (FM), 95.5, Trinidad, California ("KBAE"), respectfully notifies the Commission that due to further transmitter malfunctions on the evening of February 15, 2016, KBAE ceased operations at its main transmitter site. Despite having just returned a repaired transmitter to full power operations the prior morning following thirty days of auxiliary operations, KBAE engineers have had to return the transmitter to its manufacturer for repairs again. The problems have been identified by the manufacturer and are expected to be remedied within the next week to ten days, when KBAE expects to return to full power operations on its main transmission system. Since the February 15, 2016 shut-down of its main transmission system, KBAE has been operational on its auxiliary permit (File Number BXPH-20150518AFB).
