
Dear Ms Dortch:

This letter, filed in triplicate on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), the licensee of Station KIKR(AM), Beaumont, Texas, notifies the Commission that the Station has returned to full-power operation. Special temporary authority is no longer required.

After Cumulus reported to the Federal Communications Commission that this Station was operating at reduced-power, the engineer that oversees the Cumulus stations in the Beaumont, Texas market was able restore KIKR to full-power operation. Cumulus realizes, however, that this is a temporary solution to the technical problems it faces with respect to KIKR and is moving forward to execute the technical plan described in its Request for Special Temporary Authority referred to above. A minor change construction permit application was filed with the FCC that proposes to replace the KIKR tower and ground system. This application is identified by file number BP-20060613AAB. Once action is taken on this application, Cumulus intends to build the new facilities and file a license application.
