Dear Mr. Henderson:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 14, 2016. PMA requests an extension of the STA granted on September 30, 2015, to operate with reduced power due to a partial failure of the 5 kW transmitter.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, PMA states that during the past six months it ordered a new replacement transmitter, which should be delivered shortly.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WWDJ(AM) may continue to operate with reduced power. PMA must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that PMA will notify our staff (via e-mail or letter) before the expiration date shown below to verify that the station has resumed licensed operations per BZ-20060126ARK using the new transmitter.
