Dear LSC:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 18, 2016. LSC requests an extension of the STA granted on August 13, 2015, to operate station KMJE(AM) with emergency antenna facilities pursuant to Section 73.1680.¹ In support of the request, we noted that LSC's application (BP-20160330AAB) remains pending before the Commission.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station KMJE(AM) may continue to operate with one of the nighttime site towers using a maximum of 0.12 kW (with no change to the licensed daytime site facility). It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. LSC must also use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

¹ KMJE(AM) is licensed for DA operation at two different sites on 890 kHz with 10 kW day and 0.48 kw night, and BP-20160330AAB proposes to relocate the nighttime facility to the daytime site using a new pattern.

This authority expires on October 11, 2016.
