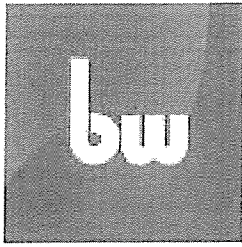

The replacement KVCE-AM Day site transmitter was installed and tested at full power on November 25, 2015. All operational parameters were normal.

Subsequently it was determined the Orban audio processor had also been damaged. This was repaired and reinstalled on December 11, 2015. This allowed the KVCE-AM Day Site to resume normal broadcast operations with no noticeable changes to the existing operating parameters.
