Dear Counsel:

This letter concerns the above-referenced construction permit and covering license application of San Diego Community College District ("SDCCD"), licensee of noncommercial educational ("NCE") Station KSDS (FM), San Diego, CA for operation of KSDS at 3.0 kW effective radiated power (ERP). Radio Television S.A. de C.V and Bay City Television, Inc. (together "XETV") filed a petition for reconsideration on April 8, 2002 against the grant of the construction permit, and also raised objections against the covering license application. SDCCD opposes XETV's pleadings.

The matters raised in the pleadings are essentially those raised previously in conjunction with KSDS' application BPED-19940802MA for higher power directional operation. By letter from Peter Doyle, Chief, Audio Division, Media Bureau, DA 06-2253, 21 FCC Rcd 13015, dated October 31, 2006, XETV's objections were denied, while the KSDS construction permit for 22 kW operation was granted subject to a condition that KSDS operate with a vertically polarized antenna, and that KSDS take reasonable steps to resolve interference to viewers' reception of Channel 6 caused by KSDS operation. Since the 3 kW facilities authorized in construction permit BPED-20020219ABE have less of an impact than the more recently authorized 22 kW operation, and as KSDS has operated since April 2002 at 3 kW without significant complaints, we find it appropriate to grant the covering license application subject to the same conditions listed in the October 31, 2006 letter.

Accordingly, the petition for reconsideration filed by XETV against construction permit BPED-20020219ABE, and XETV's informal objections against grant of the covering license application BLED-20020405ABG, ARE DISMISSED. License application BLED-20020405ABG IS GRANTED with vertical polarization only, and with a condition requiring reasonable steps to assist XETV (TV) viewers in mitigating interference from KSDS (FM) operations.
