Dear Mr. Chiesa:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 5, 2016. RVCM requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on November 13, 2007, to operate Station WVZN with temporary facilities at an alternate site due to loss of the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, RVCM stated that it plans to amend BP-20140425AAA before July 22, 2016, as requested in the Commission's letter dated January 22, 2016.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WVZN(AM) may continue to operate with the following facilities:

¹ WVZN is licensed for ND operation on 1580 kHz with 0.5 kW day and 0.005 kW night, and BP-20140425AAA proposes a new ND facility at a new site.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RVCM must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 24, 2016**.
