On behalf of Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), the licensee of FM station WMSO, Quitman, Mississippi and pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) of the Commission's rules, this letter is to notify the Commission that WMSO has been operating at reduced power since November 2, 2015.

WMSO has been operating at reduced power since November 2, 2015 due to a transmitter problem. EMF replaced the old transmitter, however, the new transmitter was damaged in shipping and did not work. Another transmitter is being sent and will be installed within the next few weeks. In the event EMF is unable to return WMSO to full power operations within 30 days, EMF will request special temporary authority to allow WMSO to continue operating at reduced power, as required by the Commission's rules.
