## Re: KJAV(FM), Alamo, TX (Facility ID No. 51957) Notification of Reduced Power Operation

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of MBM Texas Valley LLC ("MBM"), the licensee of radio station KJAV(FM), Alamo, Texas, this is to notify the Commission that KJAV(FM) is operating at reduced power with an auxiliary transmitter. On the night of July 24, 2015, an individual broke into the KJAV(FM) transmitter building and vandalized several pieces of equipment, including the KJAV main and auxiliary transmitters.<sup>1</sup> The vandalism rendered the main transmitter unusable; however, MBM personnel have been able to keep KJAV(FM) on the air via its auxiliary transmitter, albeit at approximately 36% of the station's authorized power.

Station personnel are working diligently to restore KJAV(FM) to full power as quickly as possible. In the event that the station cannot resume full power operation by August 23, 2015, MBM will seek special temporary authority for KJAV(FM) to continue to operate at reduced power until the necessary repairs have been completed.
