This is in reference to the requests filed February 2 and 9, 2007, on behalf of Cox Radio, Inc. ("CRI"), for special temporary authority (STA) to operate Station WCFB with emergency antenna facilities following destruction of the licensed site by a tornado.

Our review indicates that, subsequent to the filing of the subject STA requests, CRI filed and was granted Construction Permit BPH-20070213AAN, for new, permanent facilities; and that Application BLH-20070305ACQ, for license to cover the permit, was granted on March 20, 2007. In light of the foregoing, STA is no longer necessary.

Accordingly, the February 2 and February 9, 2007, requests for STA ARE HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 CFR Section 0.283.
