Dear Mr. Denning:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 13, 2016. RLHC requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 25, 2011, to operate with an emergency ND antenna day and night (or at night with parameters at variance).\(^1\) In support of the request, we noted that RLHC filed an FCC Form 301 application BP-20160610AAX (to correct coordinates and utilize the existing daytime tower at night using reduced power).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
  the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
  the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WKY may continue to operate with an emergency ND antenna using the 94.6° night tower #2(SW) with

a maximum of 5 kW day and 1.25 kW night, or with the night DA parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RLHC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on December 14, 2016.
