



To whom it may concern,

The Center for Hmong Arts and Talent does not intend to pursue its construction permit BNPL-20131114BRV and facility ID 197260 for a low power FM radio station.

We had every intention of building our station when we applied for the permit in 2014. However, due to changes in leadership and shifting organizational priorities, our board of directors is no longer interested in pursuing the station.

Our board acknowledges that our construction permit expired in June 2016 and this letter serves as our official resignation of the permit. We also wish to dissolve our timeshare agreement with Thomas-Dale District 7 Planning Council (permit BMPL20160629AAX, facility ID 195511, call letters WFNU-LP) and are supportive of WFNU-LP taking full control of the frequency.

CHAT continues to support WFNU and their use of the studio and antenna to be a voice for the community. CHAT will also maintain the partnership by having a board member or staff present at WFNU's advisory meetings.
