Dear Mr. Price:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 5, 2016. TMMO requests a third extension of the STA granted on December 2, 2014, to operate with DA parameters at variance due to multiple repairs/modifications.¹ In support of its request, TMMO states that additional time is needed to file the required FCC Form 302 application with a day and night partial proof (or method of moment proofs) to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station

¹ WOBM(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1160 kHz with 5 kW day and 8.9 kW night.

WOBM(AM) may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that TMMO will be able to file the 302 application in the upcoming months, therefore a final STA request must be filed if that application remains pending as of the expiration date shown below.

This authority expires on January 29, 2017.
