This is in reference to the request filed on July 11, 2016. Townsquare requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on November 12, 2013, and most recently modified on February 2, 2016, to operate with an emergency ND antenna due to failure of a control cable which has rendered the day and night directional antenna systems inoperable. In support of the request, TMMO states that during the past six months all required repairs were not completed, therefore additional time is needed to complete the work and resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station

¹ WADB(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1310 kHz with 2.5 kW day and 1 kW night.

WADB(AM) may continue to operate with tower #1 (ARSN 1224828) using a maximum of 0.625 kW day and 0.25 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Townsquare must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. Townsquare must complete all repairs and then submit an e-mail/letter to the Commission certifying the date the station resumed operations per the most recent license (BML-20150806ABM) with negligible changes. Otherwise an FCC Form 302 application containing a day and night partial proof (or method of moments proof) must be submitted to update all operating parameters.

This authority expires on February 2, 2017.
