On July 28, 2016 E-String Wireless, Ltd. ("E-String") filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission seeking to assign Construction Permit BNPFT-20130830ASO for unbuilt FM Translator Station K279CJ at Fort Smith, Arkansas (hereinafter the "Construction Permit") to Salt Of The Earth Broadcasting, Inc. ("SOTE")(BALFT-20160728AHD). E-String subsequently filed a minor change modification application for K279CJ on July 28, 2016, (BMPFT-20160728AHL).
