Notice of Resumption of Full-Power Operation

Dear Ms. Dortch

On behalf of Youngstown State University ("YSU"), licensee of FM broadcast station WYSU (FM), Youngstown, Ohio, the Commission is hereby notified that, on August 12, 2016, the station resumed full-power operation. On June 16, 2016, WYSU sustained a lightning strike to its main antenna system and had been operating at reduced power since that date due to damage to the antenna system. The FCC staff was notified of the reduced power operation within 10 days of the damage in the form of an email to Dale Bickel. On July 11, 2016, YSU filed a request for Special Temporary Authority (File No. BSTA-20160711ACG) for authority to operate with reduced power. The STA was granted on July 20, 2016. The STA is no longer needed due to the completion of antenna repairs and the resumption of full-power operation.
