I am asking for an Application for Review for a matter that was originally submitted in April 2014. This involves Section 1.115 in the matter of Radio station WBAI PACIFICA 99.5 FM in NEW YORK CITY. I SENT AN INFORMAL OBJECTION based on some facts that I brought to the Media Bureau Audio Division. I submitted information that was not taken into full consideration. I objected to the renewal of the License of WBAI PACIFICA Radio. Here are the information that I put in my original objection. Once when I was at the Studios of the station a non commercial listener supported Institution someone got on the air and said that a fugitive from JUSTICE (STILL A FUGITIVE) Who was involved in a shootout of a New Jersey State Trooper, and was a member of the Black Liberation Army, and had escaped from a County Jail in New Jersey, and escaped to CUBA. The people on the air were saying she (JOANNE CHESIMARD) was a hero. I do not believe that this type of broadcasting falls into the free speech area that the letter I Received from Peter Doyle Branch Chief of the Audio Division of the Media Bureau. Said. There are other instances that I brought in my initial objection in 2014 that I believe violate the terms of the FCC license provisions of what falls under free speech. I would like this matter reviewed by the full Commission, ie the Commissioners of the Federal Communications Commission. THANK you for your attention in this matter.
