I do not believe that this type of broadcasting falls into the free speech area that the letter I Received from Peter Doyle Branch Chief of the Audio Division of the Media Bureau. Said. There are other instances that I brought in my initial objection in 2014 that I believe violate the terms of the FCC license provisions of what falls under free speech.
