Dear Mr. Brewster:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 5, 2016. CCR requests an extension of the STA granted on February 25, 2016, to operate with reduced power daytime due to failure of the licensed 10 kW transmitter.¹ In support of the request, CCR stated that an additional 60 days is needed to complete all work at the construction permit site (in order to file an FCC Form 302 application to obtain a new license).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CRR

may continue to operate KHKR(AM) during daytime hours with reduced power at the licensed site, with no change to the licensed nighttime operation. CCR must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR 1.1310. If the required FCC Form 302 application has not already been granted before the permit expires on the date shown below, a final STA extension must be filed.

This authority expires on November 26, 2016.
