Dear Mr. Nass:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 17, 2016. CBS requests an extension of the STA granted on March 11, 2016, to operate with parameters at variance due until after construction work and a method of moment proof have been completed.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CBS states that additional time is needed to complete all work and file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station KXST(AM) may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while



maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. CBS must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 8, 2017**.
