Request for Extension of Special Temporary

Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Alpert:

This letter concerns the request you filed on August 23, 2016, on behalf of Pentecostal Temple Development Corporation ("PTDC"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WGBN to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that PTDC stated that Station WGBN(AM) went silent on December 8, 2015, for financial reasons. The previous STA was granted on February 1, 2016, and expired on July 30, 2016. PTDC requests extension of its STA for continuing financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

PTDC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WGBN(AM) to remain silent until December 8, 2016. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WGBN(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., December 9, 2016.¹

PTDC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If PTDC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
