Dear Madam Secretary:

On behalf of KPHP Radio, Inc., the Commission is respectfully requested to waive or toll the January 13, 2017, construction period deadline for the above-referenced unbuilt construction permit. In support thereof, the following is shown.

In its Report and Order issued in <u>Revitalization of the AM Radio Service</u>, 63 CR 805, parag. 15 (2015), the Commission announced that Auction 83 FM translator permittees with fewer than 6 months remaining on the construction permit may seek waivers of their construction deadlines, provided that the AM station licensee proposing to use the FM translator for rebroadcasting its AM station commits to prompt FM translator station construction and initiation of broadcast operations. <u>Id @</u> FN 36.

K248DD is among the substantial majority of Auction 83 FM Translator CPs set to expire in fewer than six months if the construction deadline is not sooner tolled or waived. The Commission is respectfully requested to waive or toll the construction period deadline as follows:

Original CP BNPFT- 20030317MHB; expires January 13, 2017.

250 Mile CP BMPFT- 20160729ABV, granted August 18, 2016 Authorizes rebroadcast KKPZ(AM) Portland, OR

Assignment BAPFT-20160629AAI, consummated September 7, 2016

Requested extension date: March 7, 2017 (six months from assignment closing)

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KPHP Radio, Inc., commits to prompt FM translator station construction and initiation of operations rebroadcasting KKPZ. To that end, 250 Mile Application proposes an antenna structure which is already constructed and under the applicant's control, and the applicant is in the process of formulating plans to acquire an FM translator transmitter and related translator hardware.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission is respectfully requested to toll or waive the K248DD construction permit expiration date to the longest period permitted by the Commission.
