

Dear Mr. Walls:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 22, 2016. CCBL requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 16, 1981, and last modified on May 24, 2004, for operation with 10 kW to overcome Cuban interference.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CCBL states that the interference continues.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CCBL may continue to operate with 10 kW using the revised parameters specified in BZ-20040227ACD. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CCBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. Station WIOD must resume licensed 5 kW operations (BZ-19901121AE) if the Cuban interference ceases, or upon official notice from the Commission. This authority expires on **March 23, 2017**.
