Hispanic Target Media, Inc. ("HTMI") Permittee of the above referenced construction permit hereby requests TOLLING until the licensee of KBHH(FM), Kerman, CA (Facility No. 82805) (the "Farmworker Educational Radio Network, Inc.") and tower owner is granted permission by the Fresno County Planning & Zone Department for a 10-meter increase in tower height of the KBHH tower, which will permit co-location and construction of HTMI's permit, File No. BNPH-20110630AGU (Exhibit A)


Hispanic Target Media, Inc. hired broadcast engineer W. Jeffrey Reynolds of duTreil, Lundin & Rackley, Inc. to perform a study to determine alternative tower locations acceptable for construction of the permit. His study revealed that the only acceptable tower site is that of KBHH(FM) as originally proposed in the construction permit application. (Exhibit B)

HTMI has acquired the transmitter, antenna, transmission line and ancillary equipment required to complete construction of the broadcast authorization upon approval of the Fresno County Planning & Zone Department (Permit Application No. 15-1431) for the 10-meter tower height increase.

Pursuant to the tolling provisions of 47 CFR 73.3598(b)2, it's respectfully requested that the expiration date of Construction Permit referenced herein be TOLLED.

The undersigned represents that neither Hispanic Target Media, Inc. nor any party with an attributable interest, is subject to denial of federal benefits under Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 8.
