## REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF PERMIT

Computraffic, Inc. has recently had a construction permit assigned to it that was originally issued to Missouri River Christian Broadcasting on October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2013. The above referenced Construction Permit is for an FM translator to rebroadcast AM station KRAP, Washington, Missouri. This application for consent to assign the original construction permit was previously requested and granted on August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016 under the "AM Revitalization Act" and utilized the "250-Mile Waiver" request as outlined in FCC 15-142 from MB Docket no. 13-249.

As noted in Paragraph 15 of FCC 15-142, footnote 36 indicated that "A substantial majority of the approximately 1300 outstanding Auction 83 construction permits are scheduled to expire in 2016. Modification applicants in one of these two modification windows may seek waivers of these construction deadlines.... Accordingly, we find that a waiver of an Auction 83 FM translator construction deadline is resumptively in the public interest for applicants participating in one of the modification windows, provided that the AM station licensee proposing to use the FM translator for rebroadcasting its AM station commits to prompt FM translator station construction and initiation of broadcast operations"

As the construction permit for K296HA is set to expire on October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2016, just a short two months after the consent to assign the original construction permit to KRAP as an FM translator was granted, Computraffic, Inc. hereby requests an extension of time to complete the construction.
