Re: Request for Waiver of Construction Deadline Construction Permit (FCC File No. BNPFT-20130827AAH)

Dear Ms. Dortch,

Radio 74 Internationale ("Radio 74") and ACM JCE IV B LLC ("ACM") filed an assignment application with the FCC on October 31, 2016 (FCC File No. BAPFT -20161031ABX) requesting Commission consent to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM translator station W223CB, Sebring, Florida (Facility ID 142174) ("Construction Permit") from Radio 74 to ACM. With the consent of Radio 74, ACM filed a minor change application on October 31, 2016 (FCC File No. BMPFT -20161031ADA) seeking authorization to move W223CB from Sebring, Florida, to Fort Lauderdale, Florida and rebroadcast WFLL(AM), Fort Lauderdale, Florida (Facility ID 67812). Upon grant of the modification application, ACM will promptly construct the modified translator station and initiate broadcast operations.

The Construction Permit is currently scheduled to expire on December 24, 2016. ACM respectfully requests a waiver of the construction deadline set forth in the Construction Permit pursuant to footnote 36 of the Commission's *Revitalization of AM Radio Service*, First Report and Order, Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, and Notice of Inquiry, 30 FCC Rcd. 12145, ¶ 15 (2015) (citing 47 C.F.R. § 1.3), to extend the buildout deadline for six (6) months from the later of the original construction deadline, consummation of the assignment of the Construction Permit, or grant of the above-referenced modification application.
