Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the request filed February 26, 2016, on behalf of La Promesa Foundation ("LPF"). LPF requested special temporary authority (STA) to operate station WDWR(AM) with parameters at variance. The STA was filed in response to the FCC letter of January 29, 2016, which dismissed WDWR(AM)'s application for direct measurement of power (BZ-20150715ABZ). The application was dismissed primarily because of a major discrepancy in the overall height of the existing tower.

The dismissal letter stated that the station must file an FCC 301-AM application within the next 30 days and advised the applicant to file an STA request to operate with parameters at variance/reduced power. However, since it has now been over 9 months and LPF has not filed a 301-AM application, the STA request is now being **DISMISSED**.

If LPF wants to operate WDWR(AM) with an overall tower height other than that which the station is currently licensed, the station needs to file an FCC 301-AM application. In addition, WDWR(AM) must also request a new tower registration number from the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau based on any new overall height, location, and/or FAA study of the tower.
