
Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the above application proposing a change of transmitter location.

The *Second Report & Order* in MM Docket 99-25 established the definition of a "minor change" as it applies to LPFM applications.<sup>1</sup> The Commission stated that minor change applications would be limited to those specifying changes in site location of 5.6 kilometers or less. Thus, the instant application specifying an 11.5 kilometer change in site location violates Section 73.870 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, light of the above, application BMPL-20161116AAP is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. These actions are taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.<sup>3</sup>
