**Update on Tower Registration**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter is filed at the request of Susan Crawford in the Audio Division per her letter dated January 11, 2016 regarding the pending application of our client West Jacksonville Baptist Church, Inc. ("WJBC") for its station WJGM(FM) in Baldwin, Florida. Ms. Crawford requested an update no later than 90 days from the date of her letter regarding the efforts to register the proposed antenna structure. WJBC provided that update on April 5, 2016 and requested that the application be held in abeyance until June 9, 2016. This letter provides a further update on the WJBC's progress with tower registration.

WJBC has retained the services of Martin Environmental Solutions, Inc. ("Martin") based in Florida, whose efforts are being headed by Martin SVP Sherrie Leman. Martin has researched and determined that for environmental processing, notification is necessary to six different Indian tribes, and has concluded its determination of the specific submission and informational requirements for those tribes. In addition, materials including tower drawings have now been obtained and an archeological survey is being prepared for submission to the state historical preservation office, with a submission targeted for the third week of June, 2016. Finally, informal biological assessments and wildlife consultations are in progress.

WJBC will continue to work diligently to resolve this matter and respectfully requests that its application BPH-20151216AEH be held in abeyance a further 60 days through **August 8, 2016** to allow it to do so.
