Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed July 20, 2006, on behalf of Pensacola Christian College ("PCC"). PCC requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on May 2, 2006, to operate Station WPCS with reduced power.¹ In support of the requests, PCC states that the WPCS facilities were damaged by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, and that it expects to complete repairs within the next 90 days.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WPCS may continue to operate with reduced power. PCC must notify the Commission when licensed

operation is restored. PCC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 29, 2007**.
