Dear Mr. Saurer:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 17, 2016. PNHC requests a second extension of the STA granted on October 15, 2015, to operate with parameters at variance due to required equipment repairs.¹ In support of the request, PNHC states that repairs have been completed, and the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters will be filed soon.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and PNHC may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while

maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. PNHC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 15, 2017**.
