## Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the above-captioned license application and program test authority for station KHKR(AM).

A preliminary engineering study of the application reveals that the condition #2 was not fully satisfied but that the co-located stations are co-owned by CCR-St. George IV, LLC, and the filter system installed and no spurious emissions are emanating from the combined antenna system at this time.

Accordingly, authority is granted KHKR(AM) to conduct program tests in accordance with Construction Permit BP-20130729AAX and Section 73.1620 of the Commission's rules to operate on 1210 kHz with a daytime antenna nominal power of 10.0 kilowatts and a nighttime nominal power of 231 watts. Program tests are authorized with a daytime antenna input power of 10 kilowatts (antenna input current of 8.2 amps) and a nighttime antenna input power of 231 watts (antenna input current of 1.25 amperes).

This program test authority expires on March 21, 2017. It will be terminated or modified if interference complaints are received.

An amendment must be submitted to provide the following information: (1) the harmonic and spurious measurements for both KHKR(AM) and KDXU(AM) to show that the filtering equipment is working properly; and (2) KDXU(AM) must file a FCC Form 302 to return to direct measurement of power.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for ninety (60) days from the date of this letter in order to provide CCR-St. George IV, LLC an opportunity to file a curative amendment. Failure to respond or file an amendment within this time period may result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
