Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 27, 2007, on behalf of Entercom Buffalo License, LLC ("Entercom"). Entercom requests reinstatement and extension of special temporary authority ("STA") to operate Station WGR with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.

In support of the request, Entercom states that it is awaiting Commission action on an application for direct measurement of power following installing of a new remote control system and a new antenna monitor.²

Our review indicates that Application BML-20061121AKH remains pending.

Accordingly, the request for reinstatement and extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WGR may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Entercom

¹ WGR is licensed for operation on 550 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 5 kilowatts nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

² A previous STA was granted on May 25, 2006, and expired on August 25, 2006. Entercom states that, on August 1, 2006, it filed a letter request for modification of license; however, the request does not appear in CDBS and appears to have gone astray. Upon recommendation of the staff, Entercom states that it plans to file Form 302-AM to replace the missing informal letter request.

must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on January 13, 2008.
