Dear Ms. Dortch:

Rick L. Murphy (“Murphy”) and New Inspiration Broadcasting Company, Inc. (“NIBC”) filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) on October 5, 2016, seeking to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM Translator Station K260CG, Mohave Valley, Arizona (Facility ID No. 157948) from Murphy to NIBC (File No. BAPFT-20161005ABF), which was granted on November 18, 2016, and consummated on January 6, 2017.

NIBC filed a “250 Mile Modification” application for K260CG on October 5, 2016 (File No. BMPFT-20161005ABS). The purpose of the modification is to allow NIBC to rebroadcast KCBQ(AM), San Diego, California, on the translator. After grant of the modification application, NIBC will build the modified translator promptly.

The K260CG Construction Permit is currently scheduled to expire on February 26, 2017. NIBC accordingly requests a waiver of the construction deadline for the Construction Permit pursuant to Footnote 36 of the FCC’s October 23, 2015 “AM Revitalization” Order, FCC 15-142, for six months from the FCC grant of the above-referenced modification application.
