Rick L. Murphy ("Murphy") and New Inspiration Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("NIBC") filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") on October 5, 2016, seeking to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM Translator Station K260CG, Mohave Valley, Arizona (Facility ID No. 157948) from Murphy to NIBC (File No. BAPFT-20161005ABF), which was granted on November 18, 2016, and consummated on January 6, 2017.

NIBC filed a "250 Mile Modification" application for K260CG on October 5, 2016 (File No. BMPFT-20161005ABS).
